

**Integrated Initiative for Designing Future Society & Data-Driven Innovation Initiative
Joint Symposium
Call for Posters for Poster Session**

July 2023

1. Purpose

In order to realize the vision of "Kyushu University that drives social change with integrative knowledge," as stated in the "Kyushu University VISION 2030," we aim to present practical initiatives and ideas that utilize comprehensive knowledge within our university to solve societal challenges and contribute to the transformation of the social and economic systems. We also encourage understanding of and participation in the Integrated Initiative for Designing Future Society and the Data-Driven Innovation Initiative.

The purpose of this poster session is to encourage and facilitate research and initiatives aimed at solving social issues conducted by the faculty, staff and students of our university, as well as promote exchanges between researchers and students from different fields. We hope that this event will lead to social change through comprehensive knowledge.

2. Submission Guidelines

[Contents]

The poster must be related to one of the three entry points ((1)Decarbonization, (2)Medical and Healthcare, (3)Environment and Food) which are the strengths of our university, as well as either (4)DX or (5)Next Issue (a field that is expected to become a new strengths or distinctive feature of our university). It also must be related to initiatives and ideas that solve social issues through cross-disciplinary approaches.

[Eligibility]

Individuals or groups affiliated with our University

Faculty Division: Faculty and staff of our University

Student Division: Students of our University (including JSPS Postdoctoral Fellows and other researchers not employed by our University)

[Number of Applications]

Approximately 20 cases

[Awards]

In both the Faculty and Student Division:

-Excellence Award: 1 recipient

-Encouragement Awards: Approximately 3 recipients

[Presentation Date/Venue]

-Presentation Date: 2:30 p.m. -3:00 p.m. September 4th, 2023

-Venue: Shiiki Hall Galleria, Ito Campus

3. Poster Specifications/Display Method

[Poster size]

A0 Vertical Version (width 841mm x height 1189mm)

[Poster Layout]

Please include the title, affiliation and name of the presenter (or representative if a group) at the top of the poster.

[Printing and Display of Posters]

Each participant is responsible for printing and displaying their own posters.

[Display Time, Location, etc.]

Detailed information regarding the time, location and other specifics will be announced at a later date.

Note: Poster data will be available online for online participants.

6. Evaluation

(1) Judges

-Selected individuals from the Integrated Initiative for Designing Future Society and the Data-Driven Innovations Initiative

-Symposium attendees

(2) Evaluation Method

-Vote for one presentation considered the most outstanding in the Faculty Division and Student Division, respectively.

-The award recipient will be determined based on the votes from the judges selected from the Integrated Initiative for Designing Future Society and the Data-Driven Innovation Initiative, as well as the votes from attendees, taking into account the scores received.

7. Awards

The award recipients will be announced at the end of the symposium. Incentive rewards will be awarded as supplementary rewards at a later date, depending on the award categories.

Faculty Division:

Excellence Award: 150,000 yen (1 recipient)

Encouragement Award: 100,000 yen each (Approximately 3 recipients)

Student Division:

Excellence Award: 100,000 yen (1 recipient)

Encouragement Award: 50,000 yen each (Approximately 3 recipients)

8. Others

1. The presentation content must be the original work of the applicant.
2. Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, and will be closed when the number of applications reach its limit, regardless of the application deadline.
3. Please note that if the submission is not received by the specified deadline, it may be excluded from the evaluation process.
4. Photographs of posters and the event venue may be taken for documentation and publicity purposes, and they may be published on the website or other platforms. In such cases, applicant information (affiliation, job title, name, etc.) may be disclosed, so please be aware of this in advance.
5. If the presentation content infringes on the intellectual property rights of a third party (including cases where the infringement occurs after the submission), the award may be revoked even after the announcement of the results.
